The latest UN event concerning climate change was the Conference of Parties(COP 27) at Sharm El-Sheik, which recently concluded.

We knew that the assessment for meeting the 2030 SDG goals would show a negative trend, mainly due to the war in Ukraine and the consequent increased use of fossil fuels.

The achievement at the conference was the adoption of the Loss and Damage Fund, i.e., the responsibility of polluters to help countries victims of pollution adapt.
